

<u>Cutting Char</u>t-12" finished,  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 9" finished,  $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

Background

A: Cut 1[6 7/8 " (5 3/8 ")]square cut in half once on the diagonal

C: Cut 2[2 7/8 " (2 3/8 ")]squares cut in half once on the diagonal

Fabric #1

B: Cut 6[2 1/2 " (2")] squares

C: Cut 5[2 7/8" (2 3/8")] squares cut in half once on the diagonal


Fabric #2

C: Cut 4[2 7/8 " (2 3/8 ")] squares cut in half once on the diagonal

Fabric #3

B: Cut  $6[2 \frac{1}{2}$  " (2")] squares

C: Cut 4[2 7/8" (2 3/8")] squares cut in half

This block could be done up with a variety of fabrics. I am showing you with 4 different fabrics. I am giving you two sizes 9 " and 12" finished size.


## **Sewing Directions**


1. Assemble Half square triangle units.

A: Sew Background C triangles to Fabric #1 C triangles. Make 4 units.

B: Sew Fabric #2 C triangles to Fabric #3 C triangles. Make 8 units.

- 2. Lay out unit # 1 like the diagram. Sew rows. Sew the rows together. This will give you a large triangle. Sew a Background A triangle to this triangle.
- 3. Repeat step 2 following the diagram for unit #2.
- 4. Sew unit 1 and 2 together.
- 5. Lay out rows for the top half of the heart. Assemble rows and then sew the rows together.
- 6. Add this top unit to the bottom half.





Step 6. Sew the two halves together
