

Cutting Chart-12" finished, 12 ½ " unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 9" finished, 9 ½ " unfinished.

Background

A: Cut 8[2 ½ (2 ")] squares, To be used with 4 C's for quick corners.

Fabric #1

A: Cut $8[2\frac{1}{2}$ " (2 ")] squares, To be used with 4 C's for quick corners.

B: Cut 4[2 ½ " x 4 ½ " (2" x 3 ½ ")] rectangles.

Fabric #2

C: Cut $5[4\frac{1}{2}$ " (3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ")] squares. One square for center the other 4 to be used with A's.

Fabric #3

B: Cut $4[2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " (2" x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ")] rectangles.

1991 Jeweled Sampler

This is one of the blocks from this sampler quilt. It is presented here in two sizes, 12 " finished size and 9 " finished size.

Sewing Directions:

- 1. Sew the Fabric #1 B rectangles and Fabric #3 B rectangles together. Make 4 units.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of your A squares of the Background Fabric and Fabric #1.
- 3. Sew a Fabric #1 square to one corner of you C square. To the opposite side sew a second Fabric #1 square. Trim excess fabric and press.
- 4. To the other two corners sew a Background A squares. Trim and Press. Make 3 more units.
- 5. Lay out block.
- 6. Assemble rows and then sew the rows together.
