

Cutting Chart-12" finished, 12 1/2 " unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 9" finished, 9 ½ " unfinished.

Background

B: Cut 4[2 7/8 " (2 3/8")] squares cut in half once on the diagonal.

G: Cut $4[2\frac{1}{2}$ " (2")]squares to be used with F for quick corners.

Fabric #1

A: Cut 4[2 1/2 " (2 ")] squares,

C: Cut a strip $[4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $(3 \frac{1}{2}$ ")] cut 4 triangles using the large triangle from your Tri-Recs ruler set.


F: Cut 1[4 1/2 " (3 1/2 ")] square

Fabric #2

E: Cut a strip[4 ½ " (3 ½ ")] Fold in half. Cut 4 triangle sets from your folded strip using the Recs part of your ruler set.

Fabric #3 🛄

D: Cut 2[4 7/8 " (3 7/8 ")] squares cut in half once on the diagonal.

991 Jeweled Sampler

This is one of the blocks from this sampler quilt. It is presented here in two sizes, 12 "finished size and 9 "finished size. This block is a variation on the block 54-40 or Fight. This blocks uses a set of rulers called Tri-Recs. The rulers allow you to cut the triangles C and E from strips. This gives you triangles with the tips trimmed to make it easier to match the tips...If you don't have a Tri-Recs ruler set you can use the templates provided on our web site.

Sewing Directions:

- 1. Sew a pair of B background triangles to each side of square A from Fabric #1. Make sure to sew them like the diagram. Make 4 units.
- 2. Sew a triangle D from Fabric #3 to the unit from step 1. Make 4 units.
- 3. Sew your E Fabric #2 triangles to each side of Fabric #1 triangle. The E triangles have a reverse. You may want to line up both sides first to make sure you have them in the right place. It is easy to sew them incorrectly.
- 4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Background G squares. Using the quick corner method sew 1 square on the diagonal to one corner of your F square from Fabric #1. Sew a second square to the opposite corner. Trim and Press.
- 5. Sew the remaining squares to the other two corners of your square. Trim and Press.
- 6. Lay out Block.
- 7. Assemble rows and then sew rows together.



Step 1. Sew triangles to the A squares. Make 4 units.



Step 2: Sew the d triangle to unit from step 1.



Step 3. Sew F and F reversed to C. Make 4 units.







Steps 4-5: Sew squares on the diagonal to the opposite corner of large square. Trim and press. Repeat for the other two remaining corners. Trim and press.
