


# 1986 Log Cabin Barn Raising

### Center Square



Cut 1[2 1/2 "]square

### Light Side

- #1 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 2 1/2 "] rectangle
- #2 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 3 1/2 "]rectangle
- #5 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 4 1/2 "]rectangle
- #6 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 5 1/2 "]rectangle
- #9 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 6 1/2 "]rectangle
- #10 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 7 1/2 "]rectangle
- #13 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 8 1/2 "]rectangle
- #14 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 9 1/2 "]rectangle

### Dark Side

- #3 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 3 1/2 "]rectangle
- #4 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 4 1/2 "]rectangle
- #7 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 5 1/2 "]rectangle
- #8 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 6 1/2 "]rectangle
- #11 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 7 1/2 "]rectangle
- #12 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 8 1/2 "]rectangle
- #15 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 9 1/2 "]rectangle
- #16 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 10 1/2 "]rectangle

## Cutting Chart

### Center Square

Cut 1[1 1/2 "] square

### Light side

- #1 cut 1[1 1/2 "]square
- #2 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 2 1/2 "]rectangle
- #5 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 3 1/2 "]rectangle
- #6 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 4 1/2 "]rectangle
- #9 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 5 1/2 "]rectangle
- #10 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 6 1/2 "]rectangle
- #13 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 7 1/2 "]rectangle
- #14 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 8 1/2 "]rectangle

### Dark Side

- #3 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 2 1/2 "]rectangle
- #4 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 3 1/2 "]rectangle
- #7 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 4 1/2 "]rectangle
- #8 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 5 1/2 "]rectangle
- #11 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 6 1/2 "]rectangle
- #12 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 7 1/2 "]rectangle
- #15 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 8 1/2 "]rectangle
- #16 cut 1[1 1/2 " x 9 1/2 "]rectangle

# 1987 Log Cabin Star

This log cabin block is a different size than the first log cabin block the guild used. It was arranged differently to form a an overall star pattern in the finished quilt.

You use the same sewing procedure. Start with log #1 and add it to the center square. Press all seams away from the center square.

Continue to add logs around in numerical order.
