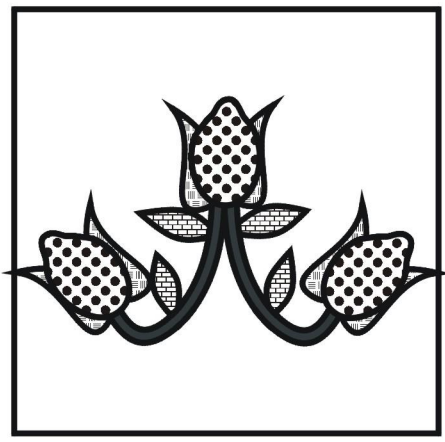


1988 Log Cabin with

Tulip Applique

The raffle quilt was again a log cabin block, but a tulip applique was added to the lighter portion of the log cabin blocks. The quilt was done in reds, greens and whites.



These templates were designed for a 12" square, but again you can make them any size you want by using a copy machine to make the templates larger or smaller. Just remember the seam allowance will no longer be $\frac{1}{4}$ ". You will need to make that adjustment..

Prepare your appliques according to your favorite method. The stems are made out of bias, that finished around a $\frac{1}{2}$ " or whatever size you find pleasing. Unlike piecing you do your own thing and it will still be all right.

Make sure that when you print this page you set your scaling option to none in your print window. If you do not do this the templates may not print out to the correct size. You should see a white box besides the words page scaling. Click the down area at the end of this box and choose none.
