

Cutting Chart-12" finished, 12 ½ " unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 9 " finished, 9½ " unfinished.

Background

A: Cut 1[2 ½ "x 16" (2 "x 13")] strip. Use with Fabric #1 strip to make 4-patches.

B: Cut 3[5" (4")] squares cut in half once on the diagonal. After sewing units will be trimmed to $[4 \frac{1}{2}" (3 \frac{1}{2}")]$.

Fabric #1

A: Cut $1[2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 16" (2 " x 13")] strip. Use with Background strip to make 4-patches.

Fabric #2

B: Cut 3[5" (4")] squares cut in half once on the diagonal. After sewing units will be trimmed to $[4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $(3 \frac{1}{2}$ ")].

1994 Fantastic Fans

This Jacob's Ladder plus a fan block was used to make this quilt plus some applique. This block is presented in two sizes 12" finished size and 9" finished size.

Sewing Directions


- 1. Sew Background A strips together with Fabric #1 A strips. Press toward Fabric #1. Cut 6 strips off of [2 ½ " (2")]. Assemble these into 3 4-patches.
- 2. Sew your B triangles together using Background plus Fabric #2 triangles. Press. Trim completed squares down to [4 ½ ", (3 ½ ")], make 6 units.
- 3. Lay out block.
- 4. Assemble rows and then sew rows together.






Step 1: assemble strips. Cut off 6 strips of [2 ½ " (2")] Assemble into 4-patches.





Step 2: Sew triangles together. Press and trim squares down to [4 ½ " (3 ½ ")]. Make 6 units.



4. Assemble rows. Sew rows together.
