
1996 Cobblestones

This was a strippy scrap quilt in blues with a touch of reds and beige background. The strips were set together with a blue striped fabric.


Sewing Directions.

- 1. Each strip is made up of two background rectangles [2 ½ " x 4 ½ "], and 3 [2 ½ "] squares.
- 2. Start with the rectangle, then to the rectangle sew 3 squares and finish row with another background rectangle.
- 3. Make as many rows as you want.
- 4. Sew the rows together offsetting the rows as shown in the diagram.
- 5. After you have sewn together enough rows for the length of strip you want you will trim off the jagged edge of your strips.
- 6. Cut 1[10"] square cut in half once on the diagonal to fill in the top and bottom corners. This is cut slightly larger than needed and then trimmed down after


sewing to the ends of the strip.




Line up ruler along diagonal edge of strip and trim the jagged edges off with your rotary cutter.



You can make a narrow strip by using smaller squares and rectangles. You could cut your rectangles at $[2^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}]$ and your squares at $[2^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}]$.
