

2001 Devine Nines

This quilt was made up of this block plus nine patch blocks. It had applique borders with vines, tulips, and leaves around it. The block is presented here in a 9" finished, 9 ½ " unfinished size. The quilt was in shades of red and green with a light background.

Sewing Directions

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 8 Fabric #1 C squares.
- 2. Sew one square to the end of a Background B rectangle. Follow Diagram A. Trim and press. Make 4 like Diagram A. and 4 like Diagram B.
- 3. Assemble a unit using two units from step 2 and a C square from Fabric #1 and Background A square. Make three more units.
- 4. Lay out block and assemble.

Cutting Chart

Background

A: Cut 4[2 3/4 "]square

B: Cut 8[2 1/4 ' x 2 3/4 "]rectangles to be used with 8 C squares for quick corners.

D: Cut $4[1^{\frac{1}{2}}$ " x $4^{\frac{1}{2}}$ "]rectangles

Fabric #1

C: Cut $12[2\frac{1}{4}]$ squares. 8 are to be used

with B for quick corners. E: Cut 1[1 ½ "] square






