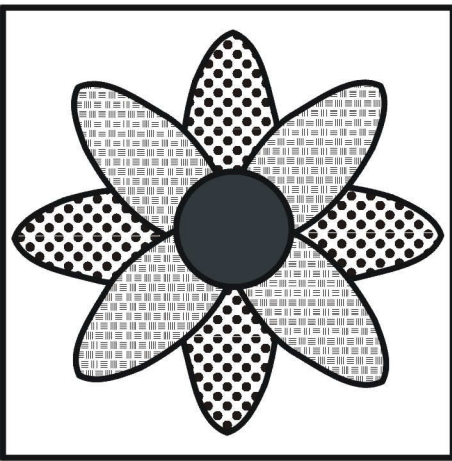
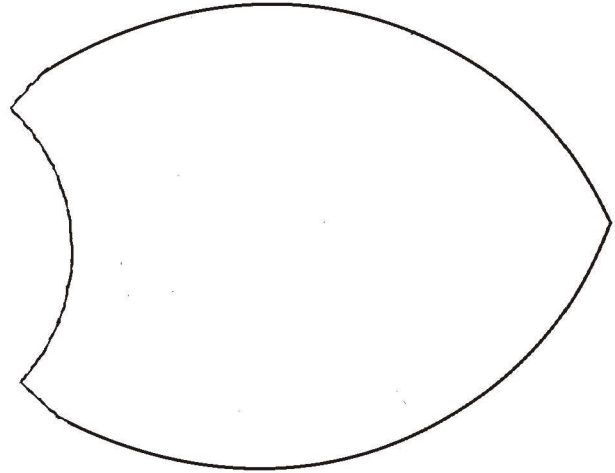
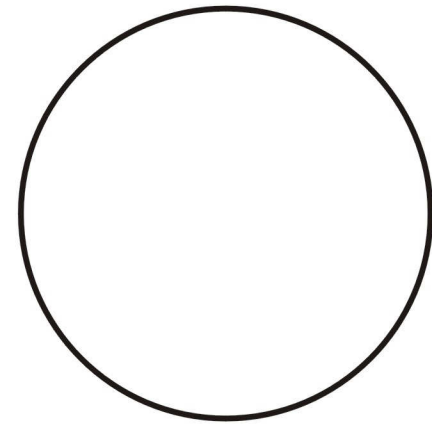


2003 Dahlia

This quilt had an appliqued dahlia block set on point and separated by a pieced sashing.. The quilt had an elaborate border of vines and leaves with a appliqued dahlia in each of the corners.



Cut a 12 ½ “ square for your background. Prepare your appliques using your favorite method. Make a total of 8 petals and 1 center. Remember to add seam allowances. You can assemble the petals in a couple of ways. You can place your petals straight up down and left and right and then place the other 4 petals between the others or you could overlap each petal until you have a complete circle. The small circle then does down in the center.



Make sure that when you print this page you set your scaling option to none in your print window. If you do not do this the templates may not print out to the correct size. You should see a white box besides the words page scaling. Click the down area at the end of this box and choose none.
