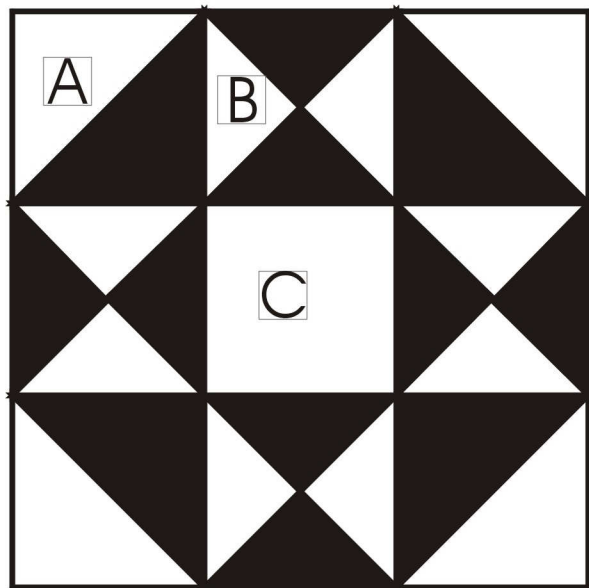


2006 Red Sampler

This quilt had a sampler of blocks done in shades of red with a red and tan background. This block is presented in a 12" finished size and 9" finished size.



Sewing Directions:

1. Sew your A triangles together. Press and trim down to $[4\frac{1}{2}" (3\frac{1}{2}")]$. Make 4 units.
2. Take your B triangles and sew together like the diagram. Make 4 units.
3. Lay out block.
4. Assemble rows and then sew rows together.

Cutting Chart-12" finished, $12\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 9" finished, $9\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished.

Background

A: Cut $2[5" (4")]$ squares cut in half once on the diagonal.. After sewing squares are trimmed down to $[4\frac{1}{2}" (3\frac{1}{2}")]$.

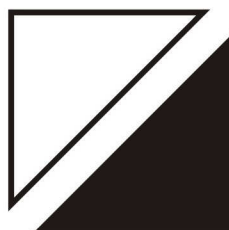
B: Cut $2[5\frac{1}{4}" (4\frac{1}{4}")]$ squares cut in half twice on the diagonal.

C: Cut $1[4\frac{1}{2}" (3\frac{1}{2}")]$ square.

Fabric #1

A: Cut $2[5" (4")]$ squares cut in half once on the diagonal.. After sewing squares are trimmed down to $[4\frac{1}{2}" (3\frac{1}{2}")]$.

B: Cut $2[5\frac{1}{4}" (4\frac{1}{4}")]$ squares cut in half twice on the diagonal..



Step 1: Press and trim to $[4\frac{1}{2}" (3\frac{1}{2}")]$. Make 4 units.



Step 2: make 4 units.
