

Cutting Chart-8" finished, 8 1/2 " unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 4 "finished, 4 1/2" unfinished.

Background:

A: Cut 8[2 ½", (1½")]squares B: Cut 4[3". (2")]squares. Cut in half on the diagonal once. Trimmed to [2 ½", (1 ½")] after sewing.

Fabric #1:

B: Cut 4[3". (2")] squares. Cut in half on the diagonal once. Trimmed to [2 ½ ", (1 ½ ")] after sewing.

2007 Reach for the Stars


This was a sampler of stars. This one is presented in two sizes a 8 "finished, and a 4" finished size. The background was done in a variety of blues.

Sewing Directions:

- 1. Sew your A triangles together using one background triangle with one Fabric #1 triangle. Press and trim down to [2 ½", (1 ½ ")]. Make 8 units.
- 2. Lay out block.
- 3. Assemble rows, then sew rows together.
