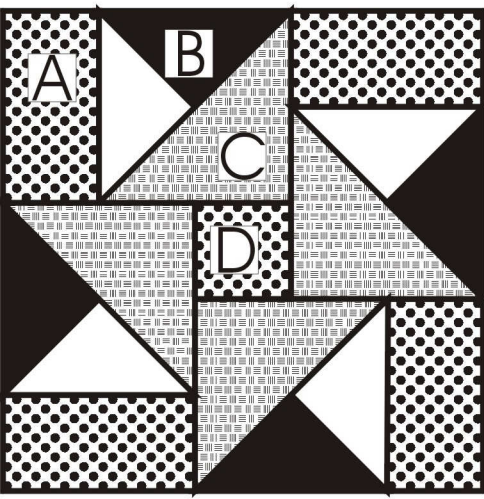


# 2007 Reach for the Stars





Here is a second block from the quilt. This block requires the technique of partial seams. It is presented in a 10" finished size.


## Sewing Directions


1. Sew a Background B: triangle to a Fabric #1 triangle. Make sure to follow the diagram. Make 4 units.
2. To the unit in step 1 Sew a Fabric #3 triangle.
3. To the unit in step 2 add the rectangle A. Make 4 units.
4. Sew a unit to the D square sew only a short partial seam about half the length of the square.
5. Add another unit to the one in step 4 sewing a complete seam. Continue to add units around the center square until all 4 units are added.
6. Complete the partial seam made in step 4 as your final seam.

**Cutting Chart**-10" finished, 10 ½" unfinished

**Background**   
B: Cut 1[5 ¼"] square cut in half twice on the diagonal.

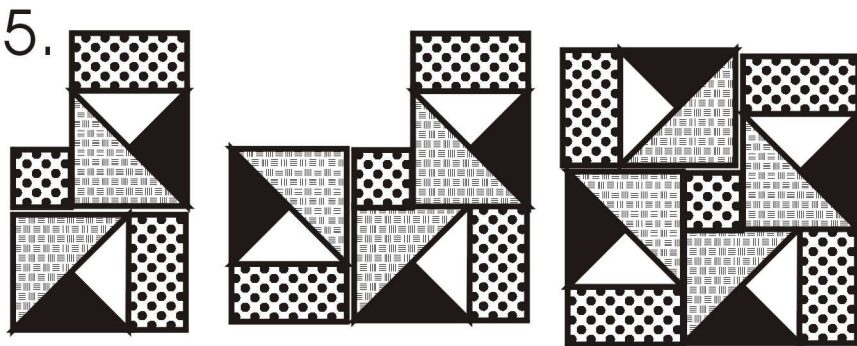
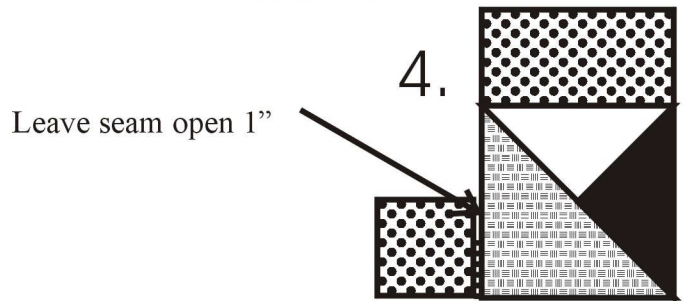
**Fabric #1**   
B: Cut 1[5 ¼"] square cut in half twice on the diagonal..

**Fabric #2**   
A: Cut 4[2 ½" x 4 ½"]  
D: Cut 1[2 ½"] square

**Fabric #3**   
C: Cut 2[4 7/8"] squares cut in half once on the diagonal.



Make 4 units.
