

2008 Total Eclipse

This quilt was done in Batiks and was made up of paper pieced block. The foundation for the center is given here. This center was surrounded by a larger arc. The foundation here can be used to make a 6" finished size block. You can of course increase or decrease the size by using a copy machine to make it larger or smaller.

Cutting Chart for 6" finished size

H-1, H-10: Cut 2[2" x 4"] rectangles

H-2: Cut 4[2 ½" x 4 ¼"] rectangles

Sec2, Sec4, Sec6, Sec8, Sec10: Cut 5[1 ½" x 6"] rectangles

Sewing Directions:

1. Sew on the solid lines following the number sequence.
2. After completing the foundation. Remove the paper. Press under ¼" on curved edge.
3. Lay on a 6 ½" square. Align the sides of the foundation with the sides of the square. Topstitch the curved edge to the solid square with the stitch you prefer.
4. Trim out the background fabric from behind the
