

2010 Champaign Stars

This quilt has two alternating blocks. One block was 54-40 or Fight which we have used before. Here is the second block. The blocks were then set on point. The alternate block is a variation of Jacob's Ladder. It is presented here in two sizes, a 12 "finished, and a 9 "finished.

Cutting Chart -12" finished, 12 ½ " unfinished is the first number the second number in the parentheses is for a 9 " finished, 9 ½ " unfinished.

Background

A: Cut 10[2 ½ " (2")]squares

Fabric #1

B: Cut 2[5" (4)] squares cut in half once on the diagonal. After sewing these are trimmed to $[4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $(3 \frac{1}{2}$ ")]

Fabric #2

B: Cut 2[5" (4)], squares cut in half once on the diagonal. After sewing these are then trimmed down to [4 ½ " (3 ½ ")]

Fabric #3

A: Cut 10[2 ½ " (2")]squares

Sewing Directions:

- 1. Sew B triangles together on the diagonal. Press and trim completed units down to $[4 \frac{1}{2}$ ", $(3 \frac{1}{2}$ ")]
- 2. Sew A squares together using one of each color.
- 3. Assemble into four-patches.
- 4. Lay out Block and assemble rows. Sew rows together.
