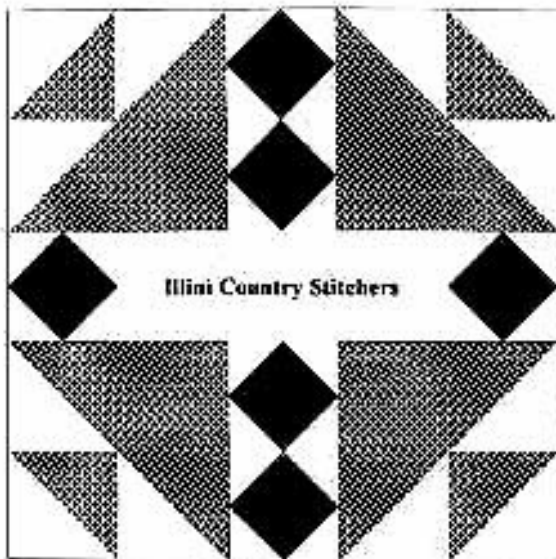





ICS NAME TAG



-  Background-White or white on white
-  Navy Print
-  Orange Print

Foundation Piecing instructions for ICS name tag.

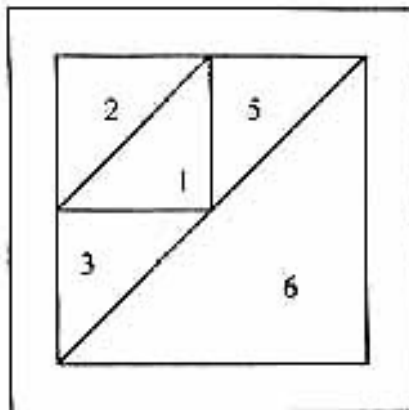
1. Cutting

Dk. Blue cut 2 3" squares, cut in half for 4 triangles.
 Cut 2 2 1/2 " squares, cut in half for 4 triangles.
 White cut 6 2 1/2 " squares, cut in half for 12 triangles.

cut 2 rectangles 1 1/4" by 2 1/8"

cut 1 rectangle 1 1/4" by 4 1/2"

Orange-Wonder under a 6" square of orange print.
 After it cools remove backing. Using A as a pattern
 cut six small squares from the orange.



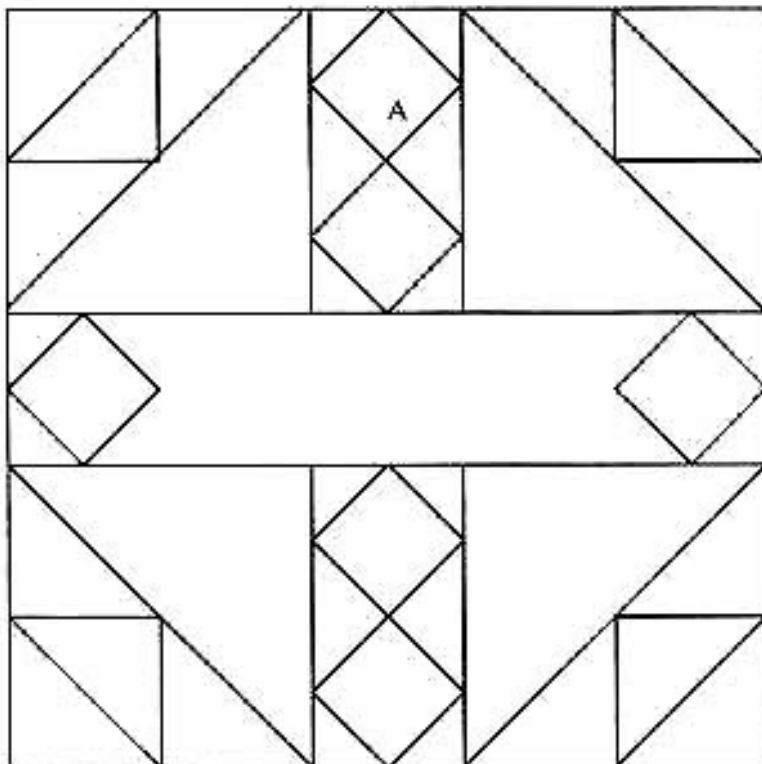
Foundation square

2. Make four corner units, trace the foundation 4 times to paper, muslin or EZ Tear.

Place a small blue triangle right side up on the right side of foundation piece (The side that does not have the lines marked on it. Place white small triangle over the orange triangle, flip foundation over and sew on the line between piece 1 and 2.

Finger press, trim excess, flip over and place piece 3 (white triangle), flip over and sew. Repeat for piece 4. Place the blue triangle on the the right side, flip over and sew. Press and trim seam allowance down to 1/4 inch. Repeat three more times.

3. Assemble block. Using your wonder under orange squares, place in the correct position, then iron in place. Stitch around orange squares, straight sitch or zig zag. Sign name, layer with batting and backing, bind edges.
